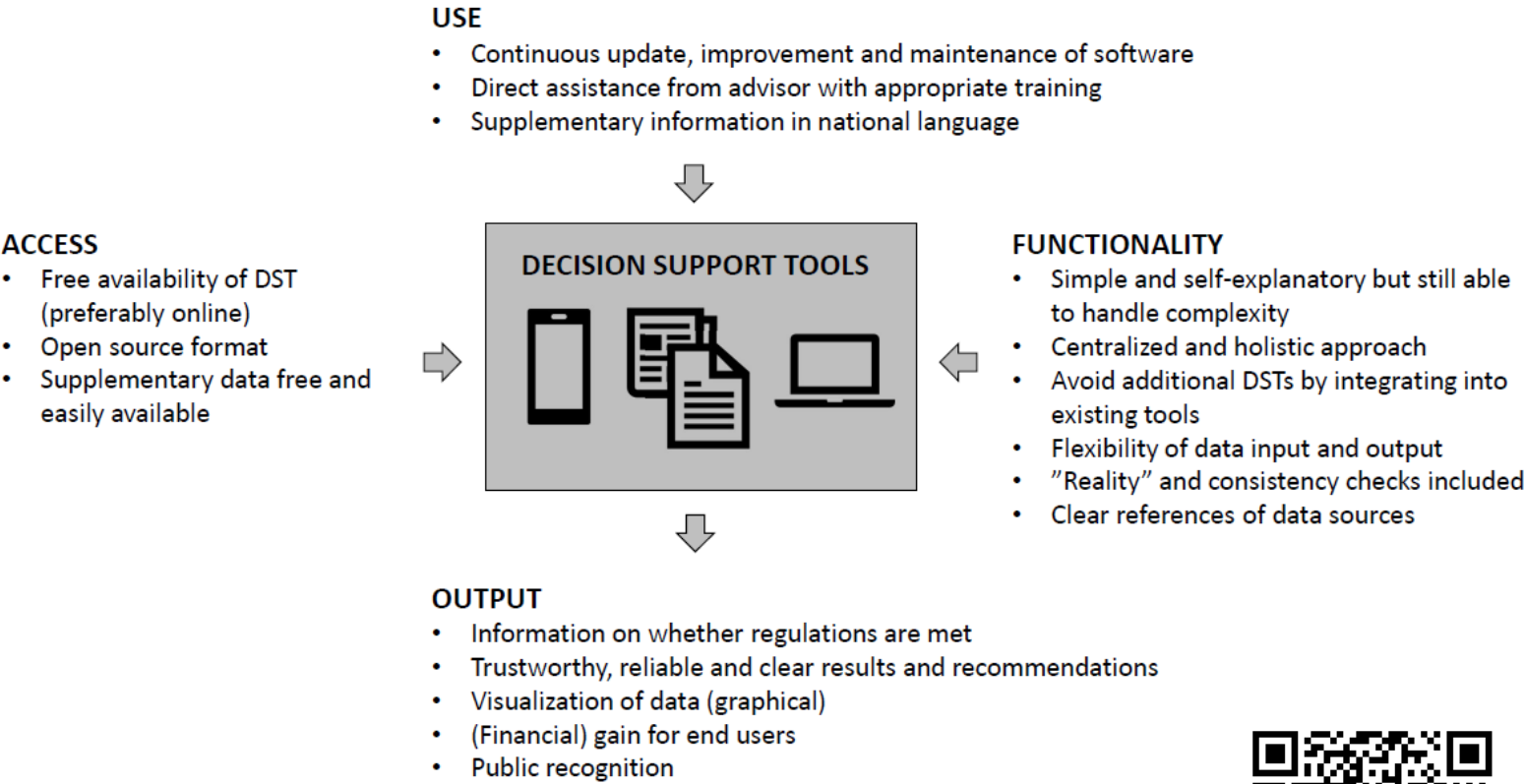

Decision support tools (DSTs) provide advice, training and communication that help implement measures to protect drinking water quality.



It is important that DSTs are designed to meet the requirements of different end users, spatial scales (e.g. local, regional) and pollutants (nutrients, pesticides, etc.).

Successful DSTs should fulfill most of the criteria below.
